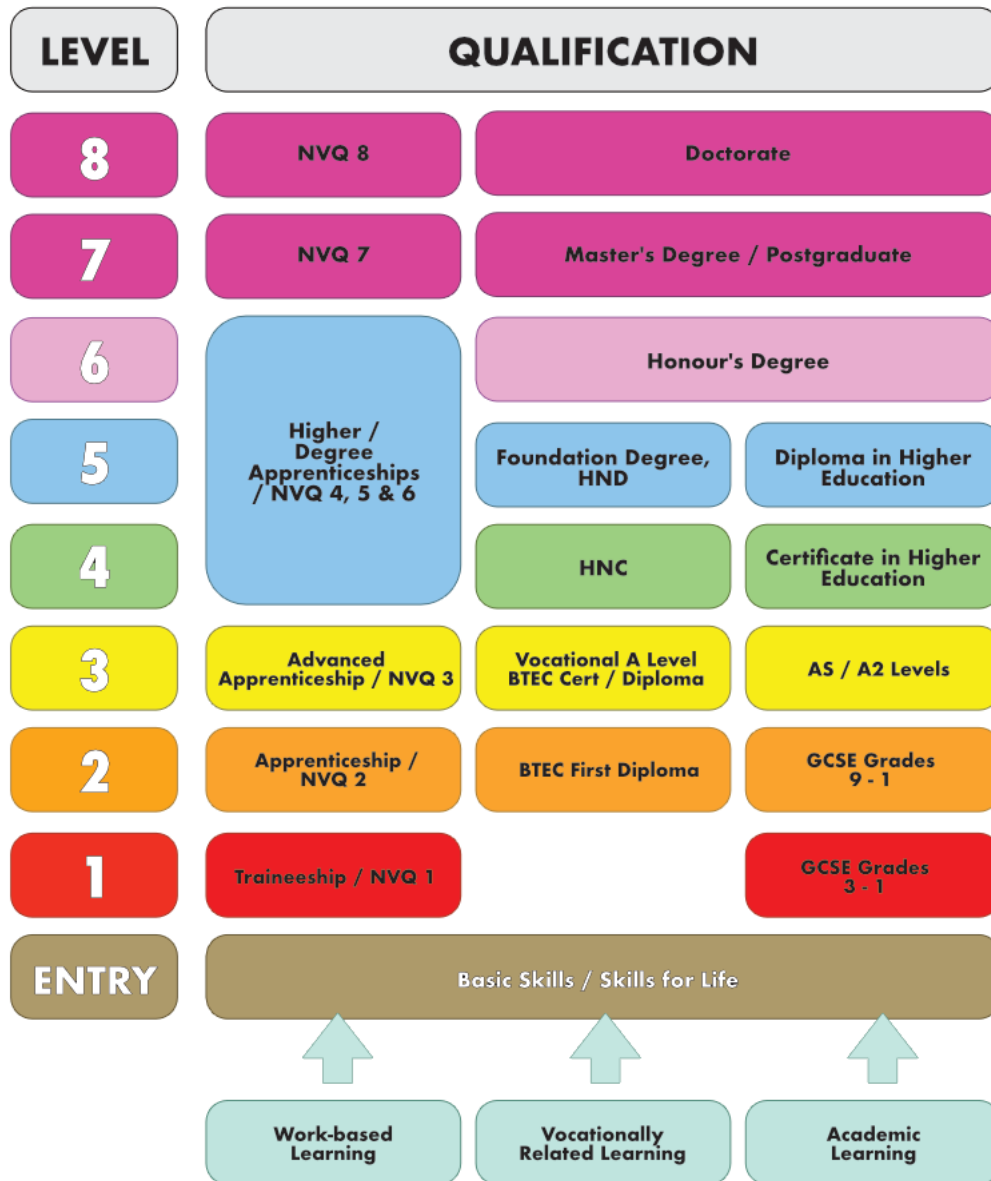




Pathways after GCSE explained



Once you have completed your **GCSEs** you'll have your **level 2 qualifications** under your belt (well done!)

After this, **during year 12 and 13**, you'll be studying for **level 3 qualifications**. These can be:

- Advanced apprenticeships
- BTEC Cert/Diplomas
- A Levels
- T Levels

At 18, you'll leave school and begin working or continue to study using the following paths:

- A **level 4 art foundation course** (which leads onto an arts based 3 year degree course)
- Honour's degree (**level 6**)
- Degree apprenticeships (please see the apprenticeships explained link for more information on this (**Level 6**))
